COVID-19 Vaccine



What is COVID-19 Vaccine?

A product which is produced partially or wholly from the virus or bacteria structure which has been destroyed or weakened, or from protein subunit of COVID-19 virus to develop immunity against COVID-19



Why?

- To break the chain of COVID-19 infection
- To protect the frontliners
- To build strong immune system



Where?

- A total of **605 Vaccination Administration Centres** have been identified



How much?

- **2 Doses** per individual



Who and When?

PHASE 1 (February – April 2021)

Priority Group 1

Frontliners comprising of public and private personnel

500,000 People

Priority Group 2

Frontliners consisting of essential services*, defense and security personnel

PHASE 2 (April – August 2021)

Priority Group 1

Remainder of healthcare workers as well as those in essential services and defence and security personnel

9.4 Million People

Priority Group 2

Senior citizens aged 60 and above, high-risk group, people with disabilities (OKU)*

PHASE 3 (May 2021 – February 2022)

Priority Group

Residents aged 18 years and above (citizens & non-citizens)

Priority is given to **Red Zone**, followed by **Yellow Zone** and finally **Green Zone**

Target of 13.7 million people / more
